(1) After returning to school and locking the phone in the cabinet every morning, S1 to S3 students are required to stay in the school hall to study or to read, while S4 to S6 students should go to the classroom to prepare for their lessons.

(2) Points to note during recesses:

- i. When using the toilet, students need to line up following the white instruction signs on the floor and keep social distance.
- ii. Eating is strictly prohibited during recess, and the canteen will remain closed. Students are reminded to have breakfast before going to school.
- iii. All activities in the playground will be suspended.
- iv. Students should only drink water while keeping social distance. After drinking water, students have to wear their mask and clean their hands as soon as possible.
- v. Students are required to return to their classroom as soon as possible after the short break to prepare for the next lesson.

(3) Students need to always pay attention to their personal hygiene, wash their hands frequently, and maintain proper social distance. Let us all work together to take preventive measures and fight against the epidemic together with the hope of resuming normal campus life as soon as possible

Monthly Report of Subject-Panels and Groups

【November 2020】

English Language

1. Book Report Competition
To encourage students to share what they have read, a book report competition will be organized for S1-S3 in November. Each student can submit one entry. The five most outstanding book reports from each form will win an award.
2. "Bringing Lines to Life"
To promote a reading culture, a handful of worth-reading books are recommended by teachers and students. Interesting quotes and some of their lively lines from the books will be displayed on the school campus.

Biology

1. Evacuation drills were conducted in October to raise students' awareness of laboratory safety.
2. To build up students' self-regulated learning habit, they have to prepare the content before lessons and draw a conclusion or write down key points during lessons.
3. S5 students participated in the online field studies course organized by Ho Koon Nature Education cum Astronomical Centre on 23rd October. Before the studies, they had to complete the quizzes on the learning platform for biology field studies. Students need to observe and record animals, plant species and the abiotic factors during the online field studies. They need to hand in a report afterwards. During the course, they should be able to understand the functioning of an ecosystem.

Integrated Science

Owing to the uncertainty of the spreading of COVID-19 during this period, all parks and museums will not confirm our booking in advance. Concerning the safety of our students, all S1 science visits will be postponed to the second term and we will try our best to arrange the visits later. If we still cannot arrange any visits in the second term, we will have other activities that will enrich the horizon of our S1 students in science. All S1 students will have to submit the project learning report after the visits or special activities.

Information and Communication Technology Subject

Moral, Civic Education and National Education Group

1. 4 students, 5B Chen Hung Ying, 5B Ding Shi Xing, 5C Hung Sze Nga and 5C Lam Tsz Wing participated in an online competition about knowledge of Basic Law in August organised by Joint Committee for The Promotion of The Basic Law of Hong Kong and all were awarded Certificates of Merit.
2. S4 students taking Chinese History were introduced and assigned to watch some memorial activities about The 918 Incident so as to raise their awareness of the identity of being Chinese and understanding of the incident.
3. S1-S6 students were assigned and encouraged by Liberal Studies teachers to take part in a cross-curricular activity of our Group and Liberal Studies, organised by Zhong Shan

University in which students answered some questions about the Basic Law so that their awareness of Hong Kong citizen identity and understanding of the Basic Law were boosted.

4. In order to allow our students to know more about our school staff members and promote the caring atmosphere of our school, on the board of our group, new staff members were introduced. Welcome to the LCDMC family!
5. On 21st October, a talk about how to prevent viruses organised by the World Vision were held for S1-S2 students so that they could learn more about how globalization affects the anti-Covid-19 tasks, the children in Hong Kong and poor areas in different parts of the world faces the pandemic. Hopefully students would be more willing to help the needy in the future.
6. S1 and S3 students joined a competition about National Education organised by The Church of Unite Brethren in Christ Social Service Division which was a cross-curricular activity of our group, Chinese History and History. Through joining this competition, students' awareness and understanding of the Chinese culture, history and nation were raised.

Student Guidance Group

2. To help S6 students reduce their examination stress, S6 Stress Management Workshop (中六紓緩壓力工作坊) will be held by the school social worker in November. Details will be announced later.

3. The Peer Counseling Program have started to recruit members in October. The first meeting will be arranged in November to let counselors introduce themselves and share their expectations of the program.

4. Healthy School Ambassadors

10 of the Peer Counsellors also joined the program of Healthy School Ambassadors to establish a positive peer group and promote personal growth. Also, through the program, we provide opportunities for the ambassadors to practice what they have learned, set a good example on campus and the community, and help other students adapt to school life. The first two training sessions will be held from 6th - 7th November.

5. Hand in Hand - To co-create Harmonious School Environment Ambassadors (撐得「喜」- 共建和諧校園大使)

To create a safe, supportive and caring environment for students and to foster positive atmosphere for learning and development, 10 of the Peer Counsellors will join the Ambassadors training which starts at the end of November. We hope the training program will be able to raise their awareness on the issue of bullying and fostering their empathetic understanding towards each other.

6. Student Mental-Health Support Scheme

(醫教社同心協作計劃)

Student Mental-Health Support Scheme (SMHSS) led by the Food and Health Bureau in collaboration with the Hospital Authority, the Education Bureau and the Social Welfare

Department is to enhance support for students with mental health needs. An annual screening exercise will be done in November for S2 students with an aim of early identification of students with anxious and depressive mood problems through a proactive approach.
