English Language

Christmas Activity

To celebrate Christmas this year, the NET and S1 teachers held a Japanese Haiku Poetry Workshop with S1 students in the hall on 30th November, 2020. In the first session, students learned how to write a beautiful Japanese ‘haiku’ poem about Christmas. A haiku is usually composed of seventeen syllables in three short lines. The first line contains five syllables, the second line seven syllables, and the third line five syllables. The subjects of haiku poems are about the beauty of nature and seasons. In the second session, students wrote their Christmas wish. They were excited as they could ask Santa to bring them lots of IT gadgets and toys.

Students’ creative works will be hung on the 7th floor corridor so that everyone can enjoy a festive Christmas together.

Business, Accounting and Financial Studies

Topic: 生涯規劃之《會計新丁》

Organizer: Hong Kong Institute of Vocational Education (Chai Wan)

Date: 9th November, 2020

Through the seminar, the students can understand the career path of an accountant. The content of the seminar included the virtual firm visit of HKICPA, the information about the path of becoming a certified public accountant and the information of the business operations of the accounting firms.

Biology

1. To stimulate students to expand their talents and to promote their future careers as scientists, 9 students participated in the International Biology Olympiad – Hong Kong Contest 2020 organized by the Hong Kong Academy for Gifted Education. The assessment was conducted online on 1st November.
2. 7 students participated in the activities of “Ocean Park Conservation Alliance” organized by Ocean Park. One of the themes, Acropora Coral 鹿角珊瑚, was chosen in our school. This activity allows students to implement artificial intelligence (AI) technology to help researchers integrate coral census data. Through coral conservation seminar, ecological survey and workshops on AI object identification and recognition, they will help establish a Hong Kong coral AI identification system, thereby enriching the knowledge of coral diversity and contributing to marine conservation firsthand. Through the participation, they will gain a deeper understanding and valuable experience on conservation work regarding Hong Kong’s biodiversity conservation. The seminars, the conservation of Acropora Coral and the briefing session of a Hong Kong coral AI identification system, were conducted online on 14th and 21st November respectively.
3. To stimulate students’ active interest in Biology, to challenge, expand their talents and enhance their scientific literacy through promoting the learning of ideas about science, 10 students will join the Hong Kong Biology Literacy Award (2020/2021) (HKBLA) organized by the Hong Kong Association for Science and Mathematics Education (HKASME) on 23rd December. Each student participant has to attend a 1-hour test with 60 multiple-choice questions. The assessment will be conducted online.

Student Association

1. The Inauguration of the 31st Student Association was held on 11th November, 2020. The cabinet named Cohesion is an appointed cabinet formed by S4 students. Wish they all the best in the organisation of the upcoming events and playing the role of being the bridge between students and the school.
2. After students started to wear School Winter Uniform, the SA committee members as well as some helpers taught S1 students to tie their ties and held some small competitions to arouse their interest and involvement.
3. In late November, the SA hoodies designed by an alumnus were sold and students could wear it with their School Winter Uniform. We hope that it would bring students a greater sense of belonging.

Student Guidance Group

1. To help S6 students reduce their examination stress, S6 Stress Management Workshop (中六紓緩壓力工作坊) was held by our school social worker on 10th and 17th of November. The workshops included the introduction of stress related symptoms and some relaxation exercises.
2. 10 of the Peer Counsellors joined the program of Hand in Hand - To Co-create Harmonious School Environment Ambassadors (撐得「喜」- 共建和諧校園大使). The training program is mainly to raise their awareness on the issue of bullying and fostering their empathetic understanding towards each other. The training will on 3rd and 10th of December after school.
3. Forest Union (森林聯盟) which is sponsored by the Equal Opportunity Commission will host a performance 'Say "No" to Sexual Harassment' to our S1 students on 9th of December. We hope our students will learn about sexual harassment through the drama and will think about how they should react to sexual harassment.

10 of the Peer Counsellors who joined Healthy School Ambassadors will have another training session on 4th of December.

Moral, Civic Education and National Education Group

1. The Tung Wah Moral Education Course for S1 to S3 students started in mid-November and was taught during Life Education lessons by form teachers. The aims are to teach the positive values and attitudes, as well as the history of Tung Wah and the services provided by the charity. Students would be able to learn more about the charitable organization. Hopefully, they would be able to serve the community and put the positive values and spirits into practice in their daily lives.
2. Seven students in S1 and S2 were recruited as Caring Ambassadors in early November. They would be helping in various activities organised in the near future in which they could demonstrate the positive values on the campus.
3. As for the LCD iTeen Leaders, there were six S4 students who participated in some leadership training workshops held by the ICAC and will assist in the upcoming events about the promotion of positive values and anti-corruption.

There was an exhibition of the introduction of ICAC in the Lion Hall. Students were encourage to visit it and learn more about the ICAC so that their sense of anti-corruption could be boosted.

4. S1 students wrote thank you cards to their primary school teachers during the form teacher period on 18th November, 2020. In this activity, students could send their love and gratitude to their primary schools. It was also a great opportunity for them to keep in touch with their primary school teachers by expressing their feelings and exploration of the new interesting secondary school life.
