Dear Parents,

This is to inform you of the recent school news, the arrangements of school administration affairs and school activities in October.

1. Morning Reading Arrangement and School Ends Times

The purpose of Morning Reading Scheme is to create a reading atmosphere in the school and cultivate students' reading habits. From 4th October 2021, morning reading session for Form 1 to Form 5 students begins on every Monday and Friday morning from 8:00am to 8:30am. (Form 6 students will have Class period and self study period.)

Parents please note that school ends at 1:30 on Monday and Friday from October onwards.

2. eClass Parent App

To further enhance home-school communication, our school will distribute school information and process parent notices via eClass Parent App in 2021/22. It is also expected that Fast Payment System (FPS) payment method will be used to collect all required fees from parents in November, 2021.

Functions of eClass Parent App:

At this stage, after installing the above application, parents can handle the following affairs:

Affairs to be handled by eClass Parent App	Details
Student attendance record	Viewing of the daily arrival and departure time of your child
Student reward and punishment records	Viewing of student reward and punishment records, signing for the notification of violations of school rules and demerits
Receiving of school notices / parent letters	Signing and viewing of electronic notices / parent letters issued by the school
Instant school messages	Viewing of the most updated school messages
Other school information	Viewing of the most frequently used information e.g. school calendar
Online payment	Paying of various school fees through eClass Parent App which is linked to the account of Fast Payment System (FPS) or AlipayHK (under process)

The school will also arrange for students to install the eClass Student App to enable them to receive relevant school information.

3. Winter School Uniforms and P.E. Uniforms

On 8 October (Friday) at 1:30 p.m. – 2:30 p.m., Fung Cheong Shun Ltd. (校服商豐昌順有限公司) will accept orders for winter school uniforms and P.E. winter uniforms. Please bring along the payment to collect the uniform on 29 October (Friday) after school.

4. Student Grant (2021/22 School Year)

The provision of the student grant (HKD\$2500) has been regularized since last school year.

Students will receive the Grant Application Form on 6th October. Please complete the form and return it to the Class Teacher on 15th October. The school will submit all collected forms to EDB for further procedures.

Guidance Unit

1. Queen Mary Hospital - Children and Adolescence Psychiatry’s nurse will come to our school on 20th of October Assembly to talk about mental health of children and adolescents for our S1-S6 students.
2. Student Guidance Group will organize Cantonese and English classes for newly arrived students in October.
3. The Peer Counseling Program will start to recruit members in October. Student who likes to know more about themselves and to learn some basic communication and peer counseling skills will be invited to join the program.

LAC

1. To establish daily routine and foster positive values, commonly-used signage, classroom instructions and positive quotes are displayed on campus.
2. To build up confidence to speak up, students are also encouraged to make announcements for various school activities on a regular basis.

Reading Promotion Group

In order to encourage students to read and write, the Reading Promotion Group is now holding a micro-fiction reading and writing workshop ,and invited a well-known writer, Leung Wai Lok (可洛) to host it. Seventeen F4 students’ participants will attend 8 workshops.

Library

✧ The Classroom Library Corner was officially launched

In the 2021-22 academic year, a library corner was set up in each classroom. Students can freely borrow books in the Classroom Library Corner (no more than 3 books at a time) by registering with the library corner assistant in the class. This service was officially launched in late September 2021.

✧ Morning Reading Scheme

From 4th October 2021, morning reading session for Form 1 to Form 5 students begins every Monday and Friday morning from 8:00am to 8:30am. The purpose of Morning Reading Scheme is to create a reading atmosphere at school and cultivate students' reading habits.

Students are required to fill in the Morning Reading Record in the booklet of LCD Reading Award Scheme and will obtain a stamp after reading a book or relevant material. The school also recommends parents to encourage children to read more at home, pay attention to children's reading record progress every week, sign and verify regularly and give appropriate opinions to their children.

✧ E-book Reading Scheme

To encourage students to make good use of e-book reading resources and promote students' autonomous learning, E-book Reading Award Scheme has been launched. The login method of e-book platform has been listed in the booklet of LCD Reading Award Scheme. Students can login to the e-book platform of HKedCity to read e-books by using computer, tablets or smart phones. Students are required to fill in the reading record in the booklet of LCD Reading Award Scheme and they will obtain a stamp after reading an e-book.

✧ 2021-2022 Mid-autumn Festival lantern riddle guessing activity (jointly organized by the Chinese society and the library)

In order to spend the annual Mid-Autumn Festival with students, the Chinese Society and the library jointly organized the Mid-Autumn Festival lantern riddle guessing activity. The activity was successfully held in late September. Over 240 students participated and the response was very enthusiastic. 40 students got a gift from the library. Class 1A won the most active participation award. Each participant received a stamp in the booklet of LCD Reading Award Scheme.
